

These Booking Terms & Conditions (the “Terms”) apply to all trips organized by The Girls Trip Co. LLC, a State of Georgia registered business that can be contacted through the contact form at <https://thegirlstripco.com/contact/> .

By paying your deposit or any portion of the trip cost, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms. If you are booking on behalf of others, you accept these Terms on their behalf and confirm that you are authorized to do so.

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## 1. Contract & Acceptance

1.1 A booking is confirmed when we have received your required deposit payment and have issued a confirmation email or invoice.

1.2 This contract is between The Girls Trip Co. and the person named on the booking confirmation.

1.3 Any special conditions or trip-specific policies provided at the time of booking form part of this contract and may override these general Terms.

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## 2. Deposits & Payments

2.1 The initial deposit to secure your spot becomes non-refundable after the standard sign-up deadline has passed.

2.2 All payments after the deposit are non-refundable.

2.3 Each payment is due by the date distinguished in your payment plan. Failure to make a payment by its due date may result in cancellation of your spot and application of the cancellation fees in Section 5.

2.4 If a Participant elects to forfeit their spot prior to the payment due date, the Participant shall forfeit only the payments previously made and will not be responsible for any future payments. However, if a Participant elects to forfeit their spot on or after the payment due date, the Participant remains fully responsible for any outstanding payments that were due as of that date.

2.5 Bookings made within 60 days of departure require full payment at the time of booking.

2.6 Although we accept attendees from all over the world, payments must be made in U.S. dollars and you are responsible for any bank or transaction fees.

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### 3. What’s Included & Not Included

- 3.1 The services included in your trip are listed in the trip description on our website.
- 3.2 The following are typically not included unless otherwise mentioned: international airfare, travel insurance, visas, passport fees, optional activities, meals not listed, and personal expenses.
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### 4. Your Responsibilities

- 4.1 You are responsible for ensuring that all information provided (including name, birthdate, passport number) is accurate and matches travel documents.
- 4.2 You must obtain and carry a valid passport, visas, travel insurance if needed, and any required medical documentation.
- 4.3 You must review all communications from us and promptly notify us of any errors or discrepancies.
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### 5. Cancellations by You

- 5.1 Cancellations must be submitted in writing to [travel@thegirlstripco.com](mailto:travel@thegirlstripco.com) and are effective at the time they are received.
- 5.2 The following fees or actions apply to late payments unless otherwise stated in your trip-specific terms:

5.3 No refunds will be made for unused services, late arrivals, or no-shows.

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## 6. Cancellations or Changes by Us

6.1 We reserve the right to modify or cancel a trip due to low enrollment, safety concerns, or circumstances beyond our control.

6.2 If we cancel before departure, you may choose from:

- A full refund (minus non-recoverable supplier costs), or
- A credit toward another trip, or
- A transfer to another trip date.

6.3 If cancellation is due to force majeure (e.g. natural disaster, war, epidemic, government restriction), refunds or credits will depend on what we can recover from suppliers.

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## 7. Itinerary Flexibility

7.1 Our trips are designed as niche group experiences for 20 to 35-year-olds as reflected in the pacing, accommodations, activities, and other aspects of the trips. We strive to deliver the advertised itinerary but may need to make changes to accommodations, activities, or transport due to unforeseen circumstances including, but not limited to, weather conditions, political events, strikes, health or safety concerns, or decisions made by local operators.

7.2 We will make all reasonable efforts to offer a comparable alternative at no additional cost to you.

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## 8. Assumption of Risk & Liability

8.1 You understand that travel involves inherent risks, including but not limited to transportation delays, illness, injury, weather, or third-party acts.

8.2 You agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless The Girls Trip Co., its employees, contractors, and affiliates from any claims, losses, or damages except where directly caused by our gross negligence or willful misconduct.

8.3 Our total liability is limited to the amount you have paid for the affected portion of the trip.

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## 9. Insurance

9.1 Comprehensive travel insurance covering trip cancellation, medical emergencies, evacuation, loss of a family member, and baggage loss is not required, but is recommended.

9.2 You are solely responsible for the adequacy and accuracy of your policy.

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## 10. Traveler Conduct

10.1 All travelers are expected to maintain a respectful and inclusive attitude toward their fellow attendees, Ambassador(s), and local communities throughout the trip. To help create a welcoming environment for everyone, participants are asked to be mindful when discussing sensitive subjects such as politics, religion, or personal beliefs.

10.2 We reserve the right to remove any traveler who is disruptive, unsafe, discriminatory, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol in a way that jeopardizes the group.

10.3 No refund or compensation will be given in such cases, and you are responsible for your own onward arrangements.

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## 11. Use of Photos & Media

11.1 You grant permission to your fellow attendees and your Ambassador/trip leader to capture photos and videos of you while in participation of your trip.

11.2 You grant us permission to use these photos or videos taken during your trip for marketing and promotional purposes.

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## 12. Privacy

12.1 We collect personal data only as necessary to arrange your travel.

12.2 We do not share or sell your personal data with or to any other organizations, except when it is required to arrange your travel.

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## 13. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

13.1 These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Georgia, USA.

13.2 Any disputes shall be resolved in the courts of McDonough, Henry County, Georgia, unless otherwise required by law.

13.3 If any provision of these Terms is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in full force.
